Christy McGovern Appointed to Lisle Village Board

July 19, 2016 - During the July 18th Village Board meeting, Christy McGovern's appointment was unanimously approved to serve as Trustee on the Lisle Village Board. She will complete the remaining term of former Trustee Rob Getz, who resigned due to scheduling conflicts with his job. Trustee McGovern's term continues through April 2017.

After staying at home to be with her children, Ms. McGovern recently accepted a position teaching Spanish to kindergarten through eighth grade students at St. Joseph School in Downers Grove. An educator, she has held various teaching positions across the country, with an emphasis in Spanish education. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Spanish from Benedictine University in May 1996.

Ms. McGovern has lived in Lisle for the past fourteen years, moving three times, but always choosing to remain within the Lisle community. She served on the Green Trails Improvement Association Board from 2009 – 2015, until moving to a north Lisle neighborhood.

Ms. McGovern and her husband have four sons and the family is active in sports, festivals, Park District activities and volunteerism. She is an avid tennis player who competed at the collegiate level and has served as a tennis and track coach. She also enjoys reading and is a member of three local book clubs.
