Lisle Police Department Announces Labor Day “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” Crackdown Results

The Lisle Police Department made five drunk driving arrests during the recent Labor Day crackdown. In addition, two seat belt citations were written. Other citations and arrests included speeding, improper lane use, operating uninsured vehicle.

Nationally in 2014, there were 9,967 people killed in drunk driving crashes, making up nearly one-third of all traffic fatalities that year. In fact, on average, more than 10,000 people died each year from 2010 to 2014 in drunk driving crashes.

The Lisle Police Department joined forces with other law enforcement agencies and highway safety partners throughout the state in the Illinois Labor Day “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” crackdown.

The crackdown, part of the statewide “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” campaigns, was made possible by federal highway safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation.
