

SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSEHOLDS

YARD WASTE

LRS offers weekly yard-waste and organic food scrap collection services to single family households serviced on the same day as the refuse and recycling. Yard-waste season begins the third week of March and goes through the second full week of December each year.

Yard-waste, also known as landscape waste, consists of organic waste materials accumulated as the result of cultivation and maintenance of gardens, lawns, shrubbery, trees and vines. Acceptable food scraps may be combined with yard-waste using the carts, acceptable containers or biodegradable bags as described. The following list is considered yard waste and food scrap:

Garden Trimmings, Branches and brush under two inches (2") in diameter, Leaves, Flowers, Tree Droppings (crabapples and pinecones), Garden Plants, Vines, Weeds and Grass Clippings, Yard Trimmings, Bread, Fruits, Cereal, Grain, Coffee Grounds, Pasta, Dairy, Shells, Eggs / Egg Shell, Vegetables

Unacceptable items: Bones, Meat, Plastic, Diapers, Metal, Poultry, Fats, Oil, Seafood, Glass, Packaging, Service ware, Grease, Paper Plates, Shells, Liquids, Pet Waste, Styrofoam

BRUSH

LRS will also collect bundled brush and tree branches of 4" (inches) maximum diameter and 4' (foot) maximum length, securely tied using biodegradable cord, string, rope or twine. Bundles may not exceed 50 pounds in weight, 18 inches in diameter, four feet in length and be manageable by one person.

YARD WASTE CONTAINERS OR BAGS

BIODEGRADABLE BAGS used for yard-waste disposal should be two-ply and 50 pound wet-strength paper bag designed for yard waste collection. Food scraps that are on the approved food scrap list may be mixed in with the yard-waste. One garbage/yard-waste sticker is required affixed to each bag.

RESIDENT OWNED CONTAINERS must be water tight, metal or plastic with handles, no larger than 34-gallons in capacity or 50 pounds in weight and clearly marked "yard waste" with a decal or "YW" or an "X." One garbage/yard-waste sticker is required per container, and should be affixed to the handle of the container.

YARD-WASTE SUBSCRIPTION PROGRAM - NO STICKERS REQUIRED single-family residents may choose to use an LRS seasonal subscription program with either a 65-gallon or 95-gallon cart provided by LRS. Food scraps can be mixed in with the yard-waste using the LRS cart. In addition to not having to purchase stickers for yard-waste in the cart, the durable cart (which is wheeled with a convenient handlebar), is another benefit for seasonal yard-waste subscribers. This service includes an unlimited amount of properly prepared bundles of brush/branches will be collected along with the weekly cart service (in season). Additional yard-waste in containers or biodegradable bags will require a sticker as described in this section, Yard-Waste Containers or Bags.

LIVE CHRISTMAS OR HOLIDAY TREES

- LRS provides a special collection of live Christmas/Holiday trees for a two (2) week period in early January with the specific weeks to be announced by the Village. Christmas trees will be collected at no charge during the designated tree collection period.
- LRS will also collect live holiday trees not included in this collection or set out for collection after the designated collection period provided one (1) Refuse Sticker is affixed to each tree.
- Flocked trees, trees with shiners, tinsel, light bulbs, glitter, wire or plastic or in plastic bags shall not be included in this special collection.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF OTHER TYPES OF MATERIALS OR ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL OR RECYCLING

APPLIANCES OR LARGE ITEMS

LRS will provide collection for all residential appliances or large household items (also known as white goods and bulk items) on the regular scheduled collection day from the curbside. Please note the number of required stickers for items as described in the proceeding rate description.

Large household items are large household appliances and furnishings to include, but not limited to; refrigerators, freezers, stoves, trash compactors, washers, dryers, dishwashers, furnaces, hot water heaters, air conditioners, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, microwaves, water softeners, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, book cases, sofas and similar furniture.

Appliances or Large Items - Stickers Required for Collection

1 Sticker = 1 small item (under 15 pounds) such as a handheld vacuum and hair dryer
5 Stickers = 1 large item (15 to 50 pounds) such as a blender or microwave
10 Stickers = Appliances such as a washing machine and dryer

ELECTRONIC WASTE (E-WASTE)

LRS collects E-Waste on the first regular collection day of every month. Single-family residents may set out the items described below using a set number of stickers. The Village of Lisle and DuPage County will continue to host E-Waste events as an additional resource for Village residents (multifamily and single family) to recycle and properly dispose of electronics that are banned from the landfill.

E-Waste items are defined as a "covered electronic devices." E-waste includes, but is not limited to, computers, computer monitors, televisions, printers, keyboards, fax machines, videocassette recorders, portable digital music players, digital video disc players, video game consoles, computer mice, scanners, digital converter boxes, cable receivers, satellite receivers, digital video disc recorders, or small-scale servers.



E-Waste may be placed at the curb in a brown paper bag, a 24" x 24" x 24" or smaller cardboard box. E-waste should be separate from the general recycling, waste and yard-waste receptacles in a noticeable location so they are easily identifiable for the driver.

Residents need to tag each e-waste item with the number of appropriate stickers. There is no maximum or minimum amount of e-waste that a resident can set out for collection, provided that each item has been properly stickered and it meets the weight requirements.

E-WASTE COLLECTION RATES

1 Sticker = One (1) small e-waste item (individual item)
5 Stickers = One (1) paper grocery bag of e-waste items (no TV's or Monitors)
10 Stickers = One (1) TV or Monitor under 19" (inches) and under 50 pounds

Residents with televisions and monitors weighing over 50 pounds or larger than 19 inches are to contact the LRS customer service department prior to the scheduled collection day as they will require a special pick-up. Pricing for special pick-ups are provided by LRS.

Multi-family households may take their e-waste items to the monthly event hosted by the Village of Lisle and DuPage County.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Residents may take HHW to the DuPage County HHW Facility located in Naperville. Residents may choose to utilize LRS HHW Home Collection Program however there is a charge for this service payable in the form of 20 refuse, yard waste/organics stickers. Special placement requirements and limitations apply. Information can be found online or by contacting LRS Customer Service. HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY

The Household Hazardous Waste facility in Naperville is open and available to all residents of Illinois. Household hazardous waste items are materials purchased for cleaning or maintaining a home. Business waste is not accepted. LATEX PAINT RECYCLING OPTION

Latex paint must be completely DRY with the LID OFF, placed next to your regular garbage with one sticker affixed to each container. To ensure latex paint is completely dried, mix with kitty litter or sawdust and leave with the lid off for at least five (5) days. Wet latex paint can leak onto the roads and streets and also cause major damage to the garbage trucks.

PIANOS OR ORGANS residents with pianos or organs will need to contact LRS to make arrangements for a special pick-up. These will be charged at a separate rate as they will require special labor and management due to the weight. Please contact LRS to request a special pick-up.

LISLE ANNUAL CLEAN UP DAY

In October every year, LRS provides a collection day allowing single family residents to set out unlimited quantities of refuse and household debris such as furniture, carpeting and bulky items, so as long as they are properly set out in accordance with the service requirements. This will be communicated on the Village website closer to that time.

The first five (5) items (including waste receptacles) will require stickers. For residents utilizing the subscription toter program, no stickers will be required.

Building materials, tires, railroad ties, hazardous waste, yard-waste or any other items considered unacceptable waste will not be collected.

Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) is proud to be the waste service provider for the Village of Lisle residents.

GARBAGE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

LRS will collect garbage every Wednesday with the exception of some holiday weeks (LRS recognizes six holidays). If a holiday falls on a Sunday through Wednesday the collection day will be postponed by one day. Residents may use stickers or a cart subscription program for garbage collection and disposal.

All materials must be placed at the curb by 6AM on collection day.



LRS SUBSCRIPTION PROGRAM FOR GARBAGE

LRS offers wheeled carts for garbage with a flip-top lid and handle bar. This subscription service offering has three cart size options to choose from. Residents who use the cart subscription program do not need to use stickers for garbage placed inside the cart. Garbage exceeding cart capacity will require one sticker for each resident owned container or individual bag as described below. LRS offers online payment options using credit cards, auto payment, and mail. Subscription services are invoiced quarterly.

SUBSCRIPTION GARBAGE SERVICE:

Subscription cart services are available with 35, 65 and 95 gallon carts. Rates for this service are increased July 1st, every year. Please contact LRS for current rate information.

LRS STICKER PROGRAM FOR RESIDENT OWNED GARBAGE CONTAINERS

Residents may use their own garbage containers with one sticker affixed to the handle of each container. Resident owned containers need two handles, may not exceed 34-gallons in capacity or 50 pounds when placed to the curb. Residents may also place individual plastic or paper bags, boxes, cartons or other disposable containers (not to exceed the 34-gallon capacity and 50-pound weight limit) curbside with one sticker affixed to each item.

Refuse, Yard Waste/Organics stickers are available at most local grocery stores and Walgreen's as well as Village Hall. For a current list of locations carrying the Lisle stickers visit: LRSrecycles.com/Lisle. The price of the sticker increases on July 1st, every year. As of July 1, 2019, stickers are \$3.08 each.

RECYCLING

LRS offers weekly recycling collection serviced on the same day as garbage and yard-waste. All households are provided with a 65-gallon recycling cart at no charge. Recyclables MUST be properly prepared, thoroughly rinsed out and free of food contamination to be accepted.

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS



PAPER

- NO used paper plates or pizza boxes, or fluorescent paper (they contaminate the paper stream with food, dye, or plastic coating) If pizza box top is clean you can tear it off and recycle it.
- NO paper towels, tissues, or napkins, which are not recyclable because the fibers are too small to reuse (please compost them with kitchen food scraps if possible)
- NO Shredded Paper – Loose shredded paper causes major sorting problems in the Recycling Facilities
- NO frozen food boxes, which are made of a hybrid of paper and plastic, and are not wanted by paper mills
- NO paper cups, which are also made of a hybrid of paper and plastic rendering them unrecyclable

- NO plastic bags or plastic film (plastic wraps, sandwich bags, freezer bags, tarps)

- NO candy wrappers, cereal bags, potato chip bags, or snack bags
- NO empty motor oil, pesticide, or chemical bottles
- NO Styrofoam, polystyrene (do not put in curbside bin)
