



**EXECUTIVE ORDER EFFECTIVE MAY 5, 2020
CHRISTOPHER R. PECAK, MAYOR
VILLAGE OF LISLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2020-32 issued by Governor Pritzker on April 30, 2020 provides that “Essential Government Functions means all services provided by the State or any municipal, township, county, subdivision or agency of government and needed to ensure the continuing operation of the government agencies or to provide for or support the health, safety and welfare of the public, and including contractors performing Essential Government Functions. Each government body shall determine its Essential Governmental Functions and identify employees and/or contractors necessary to the performance of those functions.”

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in the office of Village President by the Illinois Municipal Code, Section 3.1-15-10 as the chief executive officer of the Village of Lisle, I, Christopher Pecak, the Village President of the Village of Lisle do hereby declare and order:

1. That all services provided by the Village of Lisle are essential governmental services, and that while the public is encouraged to continue conducting business with the Village via the internet, email and phone, effective Monday, May 18, 2020, the Lisle Village Hall, Public Works and Police buildings’ service counters will be open to the public by appointment-only for consultations contingent upon the following of safety measures including, but not limited to face-covering, and strict adherence to social distancing.
2. That the May 18, 2020 and June 1, 2020 Regular Village Board and Committee of the Whole Meetings, the May 20, 2020 Planning & Zoning Commission Meeting and Public Hearings and May 21, 2020 Transportation Commission will be held in the Village Board Room, subject to protocols to ensure the safety of the public and Village employees and officials, including but not limited to no more than 10 individuals at a time allowed in the Village Board Room, face-covering and strict adherence to social distancing as well as continued availability for remote/virtual participation by Village officials, staff and public.
3. That effective 7:00 AM, Monday, June 1, 2020, Lisle Village Hall, Public Works and Police buildings’ service counters will be open for walk-in services contingent upon required safety measures.


4. That the Village Manager is hereby directed to implement operational and building safety measures including keeping counter partitions closed, floor markings that indicate proper social distancing, continued emergency staffing protocols, including availability of remote work and alternative shift scheduling, appropriate PPE and cleaning products as well as other measures recommended by public health agencies and the Village's risk management provider.
